

WHEREAS, the month of March is Problem Gambling Awareness Month; and

**WHEREAS,** research indicates that approximately 6 million American adults and an additional 1 million youth are addicted to gambling; and

WHEREAS, thousands of adults and adolescents in Washington State have experienced severe gambling problems in their lives; and

WHEREAS, public awareness and treatment have been proven to limit the rate of problem gambling and suicidal ideation in Washington and other states; and

WHEREAS, the Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling is a nonprofit organization working to increase public awareness of problem gambling, train treatment providers and gambling industry personnel to address it, enhance the availability of treatment services for problem gamblers, and conduct youth-based prevention programs; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the mental health, primary care, treatment, and recovery communities join together with the gambling industry to increase public awareness of problem gambling, its high co-occurrence with anxiety and substance use disorders, and to take measures to address this addiction;
