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



Suicide rate in WA and US, 2010-2019





Suicide by means in WA 2017-2019








Take home messages-suicide

- WA suicide rate has been higher than the national rate for more than 10 years.
- The suicide rate was **highest** in **Non-Hispanic AIAN**.
- More than 40% of the suicide in Non-Hispanic AIAN were caused by suffocation and 30% were caused by poisoning.
- More than 50% of the suicide in Non-Hispanic White were firearm related.


National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS), WA-VDRS




WA-Violent Death Reporting System Implementation Timeline




Who? Marital status, 2015-2018




Where? Death and injury at <u>decedent's residence</u>, 2015-2018




Why? Mental/substance use problems, 2015-2018




Why? Mental/substance use problems, 2015-2018

Why? History of suicide attempt, suicidal ideation, 2015-2018



WA-VDRS Suicide Take home message

- More than 50% of the injury and death occurred at decedent's residence.
- ❖ More than 30% of the suicide with a history of suicidal thoughts or plans.
- ❖ More than 20% of the suicide with a history of attempting suicide.



WA-VDRS Suicide Take home message

- History of being treated for a mental health or substance abuse problem: lower in Non-Hispanic AIAN.
- ❖ Depressed at the time of the injury: lower in Non-Hispanic Black and Non-Hispanic AIAN.
- Having an alcohol problem: lower in Non-Hispanic Black and Non-Hispanic Asian/Pacific Islander.
- Having a non-alcohol related substance abuse problem: lower in Non-Hispanic Black and Non-Hispanic Asian/Pacific Islander.
- ❖ An argument or conflict led to the death: higher in Hispanic.
- ❖ Having problems with intimate partner: higher in Hispanic.
