Washington State is adopting the new ASAM Criteria in Jan 2026, and licensed behavioral health agency providers are required to implement the new Criteria. The **ASAM Criteria** is the most widely used set of evidence-based standards when determining appropriate treatment criteria and levels of care for substance-related and co-occurring conditions. A Deeper Dive into Stock Market and Financial Tech Trading — Is it Gambling?

The appeal of high-risk, speculative investments is real for many people. The distinction between investing and gambling can be subtle and subjective. Whether you view financial trading from an investing lens or speculating as gambling, the risk of gambling-related harms among financial traders appears to be amplified by new financial technologies, which have increased access to riskier financial assets and have encouraged riskier trading behaviors.
